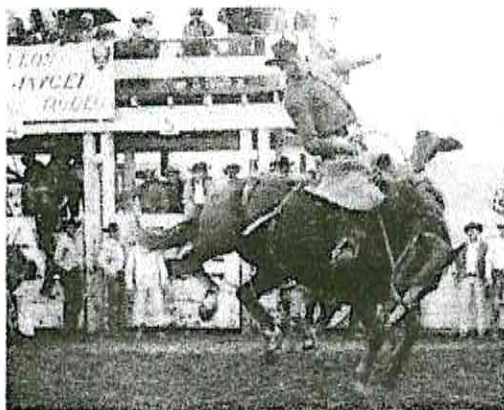

Beaverhead County High School. He is a two-way player, unselfish, dependable, coachable and focused on improving every day. Not only can Haverfield score around the basket with either hand, he can play in the backcourt, shoot the ball effectively and play defense.

He averaged 17 points a game his junior season before an injury forced him to miss the rest of the season. For his career, he shoots 42 percent from the floor and 79 percent from the charity stripe. He averages 2.4 rebounds a game and 1.1 assists.

Haverfield also brings athleticism and championship experience. Michael has lettered three times in both basketball and track and has won Class A state championships in Basketball (2015-16, 16-17), Track (2016), and Football (2016).



Michael is a member of the National Honor Society and three-time Academic All-State in basketball and track. He will graduate from Beaverhead County High School in the spring of 2019. He plans on majoring in physical therapy and sports medicine at Montana Western.

Haverfield is the son Gary and Terri Haverfield, and will join his brother Tanner Haverfield who is currently redshirt freshman with the Bulldogs.

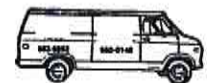

## Ghost Walk 2018

Everybody loves a good ghost story, and Montana has plenty. This Halloween season, treat the whole family to some wholesome scares in Montana's first territorial capital, now known as Bannack State Park. As the sun disappears in the west, spirits emerge from the shadows and tell tales of why their souls are still trapped in Bannack. Watch in the cold autumn air as the ghosts of Henry Plummer, Joe Pizanthus, Cyrus Skinner, Doctor Glick, and Mattie Silks return from the grave to give their version of history and bear witness to the harsh realities of frontier life.

The Bannack Ghost Walk is a family-friendly event, sure to entertain and educate anyone interested in the spooks and legends of Montana's early history. There are two shows each night, at 7pm and 9pm. Bring a good flashlight and warm clothing. Because of the family-oriented nature of the walk, alcoholic beverages are not allowed past the gate.

Families are encouraged to leave pets and children under six with a sitter—while the stagecraft of the ghost walk isn't over the top, it could cause some unpleasant after-effects for those not mature enough to understand the topic.

Admission to the Bannack Ghost Walk is \$10 for adults and \$5 for kids under 12. They accommodate 100 people per show and tickets go fast, usually selling out in September. For reservations or more information, call 406-834-3413 or visit bannack.org.

In response to "City Council-Sept 19, 2018 by MJ," PFLAG Dillon would like you to be aware of what was presented in the context of a Nondiscrimination Ordinance, in its entirety. Please note, the proposed ordinance refers to education, employment, and public accommodation.

I am a board member of PFLAG Dillon. PFLAG is an acronym for Parents, Families and Friends of Lesbians and Gays. I am here today as representative of many community members who are committed to ensuring that Dillon is inclusive and amiable place for all people. I stand here today, formally requesting that the City Council of Dillon, Montana consider expanding the definition of protected person. Specifically, I request that the council consider a nondiscrimination ordinance which intends that no person shall be denied their civil rights or be discriminated against based upon actual or perceived race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, creed, sex, age, marital or familial status, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation or gender identity or expression. I am very aware of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that out laws discrimination based upon race, color, religion, sex, and national origin. This applies to **voter registration, education, employment and public accommodations**. I am also aware of the state of Montana's Human Rights Act that protects people from discrimination based on race, sex, and disability. Please note that while I understand these Acts or laws are in place, it is evident that neither addresses one's gender identification and/or expression nor one's sexual orientation. This leaves room for discrimination.

To address this discrimination, Governor Bullock issued an executive order in 2016. Although this executive order protects LGBTQ state employees and contractors, it fails to meet the needs of the majority of Montanans, and specifically, the majority of the LGBTQ community in Dillon. I, along with many other Dillon residents, request that this council consider expanding our city's definition of protected person in order to protect ALL people.

In preparation for this proposal we, meaning PFLAG and other invested community members, were faced with the idea that discrimination does not exist in Dillon as Dillon is a nice, quiet town. Dillon is a lovely community, however, let me share this testimony." My name is Austin. I am young gay man who lived in Dillon for a period of five years. As a gay man, I found Dillon to be hostile and unkind towards LGBTQ people. I found myself a subject of mockery because of my sexuality. I have been called every homophobic slur that could be thought of. These experiences occurred while doing everyday things like shopping. This is an all too often experience that LGBTQ people face. Many want to look at Dillon as a friendly, welcoming community only to be met with hostility and aggression over their orientation. I constantly planned for the day that I would leave Dillon, never to look back. Dillon is not a town that I would ever look back on and remember in a happy manner. For some LGBT people, Dillon is far from home, it is hell."

You might be thinking, that's just one man's experience...this can't possibly be what other LGBTQ people experience. Here's is what we discovered when conducting an anonymous community wide survey regarding LGBTQ experience of discrimination in Dillon. Please note the numbers reported indicate discrimination based on being perceived as LGBTQ. As you can see, 43 individuals participated. Please remember that the discrimination occurred in Dillon as a result of being perceived as LGBTQ. When speaking with community health providers, these providers indicated that they serve individuals from the LGBTQ community who report experiencing ample discrimination in our community. Several human or public service agencies, such as the Community Support Center, confirmed this. In fact, in your original packet you received a copy of some of their letters of support. Business owners also reported that some of their employees experience or have experienced discrimination. Leaders of religious institutions assert that members of their congregation have and continue to experience discrimination in our community. While we, as Dillon residents may want to believe discrimination does not occur in Dillon, the evidence shows otherwise.

I understand that a similar nondiscrimination ordinance was proposed to this council in 2014. It did not pass. My understanding is that there was great concern regarding the potential for negative financial consequences in the event that the city was sued for passing such an ordinance. I want you to know that many other communities across the state have passed a nondiscrimination ordinance. It appears that their reading of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as well as the Montana Human Rights Act generally fails to protect the LGBTQ community and therefore an ordinance was necessary. Since passing these ordinances from 2012 to current, only one community has been sued. This occurred in Bozeman; it seems that individuals within the community believed that Bozeman's Nondiscrimination Ordinance preempted state law



and was beyond the commission's power and authority. They were seeking to overturn the City Nondiscrimination Ordinance on the basis that they, based on their own Civil Rights, were in a position to violate the City's Nondiscrimination Ordinance and were therefore denied their own civil rights. While the LGBTQ community were gaining rights, the Plaintiffs believed they were experiencing discrimination. District Court Judge Brown, the judge hearing the case, threw it out noting that there was not sufficient evidence that the plaintiffs had suffered discrimination or harm. The plaintiffs in the case appealed Judge Brown's decision to the state's high court. The Montana Supreme Court unanimously upheld Judge Brown's decision to dismiss the lawsuit and upheld the Nondiscrimination Ordinance. The basis of this dismissal was based on the failure to establish a case or provide evidence of harm and did not actually decide whether or not the Ordinance in Bozeman was valid. However, this does not mean that the question of a nondiscrimination ordinance's validity has not been answered elsewhere. Most recently, this very issue was addressed by the Arizona Court of Appeals. The Arizona Court cites a long litany of cases that stand for the proposition of such ordinances are warranted, appropriate, do not unnecessarily infringe on the constitutional rights of others, and are appropriately tailored to address the discrimination facing members of the LGBTQ community. You have a copy of this in the paperwork provided tonight. This reminds us all that the Civil Rights Act of 1964 serves as the baseline- it's the bare minimum we must do to protect and ensure equality. Each state is allowed to do more and each county and/or city is allowed to do more.

We have been in touch with other communities and their city attorneys to gain insight as to how they interpret the law in order to ensure that passing this nondiscrimination order was appropriate and conducive to their commitment to serve and protect their city from potential harm and lawsuit. This information is also provided in the supplementary packet you received this evening. After speaking with the Dillon City Attorney, we are more aware of the concern that he, as a diligent servant to the City, has for the potential financial consequences. With increased understanding and a deep desire to collaborate with this City Council, we have modified our proposed ordinance slightly. If you turn to page three of the proposed Nondiscrimination Ordinance (this is also in the documents you received tonight), you will see that we have modified the way in which a violation shall be handled. Specifically, we have included the Montana Human Right Bureau as the primary contact when one feels as though there has been a violation. The Human Rights Bureau will be the investigators. If and when evidence of discrimination is founded, the Montana Human Rights Bureau will be involved thus making any and all potential lawsuits a matter of the State rather than the City. We have modified this with the hope that our City need not hesitate based on potential financial consequences.

In preparation for this proposal, we spoke with many businesses and organizations in Dillon gathering insight and asking if they, as a business owner or head of an organization, would be in support of a nondiscrimination ordinance. Of the 43 organizations or businesses we spoke to, 31 were actively in favor of a nondiscrimination city ordinance. In fact, as you move through our community, you may notice many businesses with signage in their windows that indicate "All Are Welcome Here." These businesses do not just support a nondiscrimination order, but want to publicly identify as LGBTQ allies.

We also spoke to our friends, our neighbors, our co-workers and our acquaintances, asking them if they would be in support of a nondiscrimination ordinance. In an effort to show their support, approximately 250 people have signed our petition. We will continue to communicate with our community in hope of gathering more support and more signatures until the City Council votes.

To summarize, based on not just mine, or Dillon residents' reading of the law, but residents and attorneys across the state of Montana, the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Human Rights Act does not actually protect all people. Because gender identification and expression and sexual orientation is not specifically addressed, there is a gap or room for discrimination. In gathering data from Dillon residents, we know discrimination occurs in Dillon. At this point in time, this discrimination is legal. However, that does not make it right. I request that this council hear the community's plea, expand the definition of protected person and strongly consider a nondiscrimination ordinance. I appreciate your time and attention this evening. Thank you.

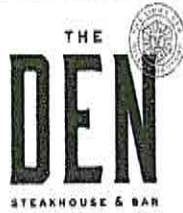

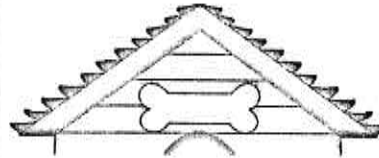

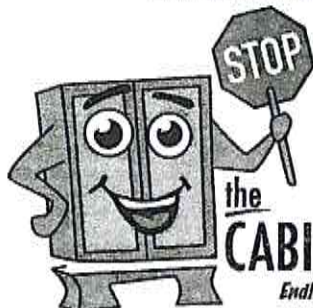
