Fatal Motorcycle Collision Near Silverstar

on Highway 41

On August 23, around 1:48 p.m., emergency responders responded to a serious motorcycle crash on Highway 41 near Silverstar. The incident involved a Kawasaki and a Harley-Davidson, both traveling northbound.

According to reports, the Kawasaki began turning around when it was struck by the Harley-Davidson. Both motorcycles tipped over and slid across the southbound lanes before coming to rest on the shoulder. The driver of the Harley-Davidson was pinned beneath the motorcycle during the crash.

Both drivers were transported to a nearby medical facility. However, tragically, the driver of the Harley-Davidson succumbed to his injuries the following day. Neither driver was wearing a helmet at the time of the crash.

Upland game bird hunters and archers

Upland game bird season opens Monday, Sept. 1, and archery season opens Sept. 6, coinciding with the kickoff of Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks' Bear Aware Month.

Upland game bird hunters and archery hunters are often hunting in areas where grizzly bears are active and looking for food, like creek bottoms with chokecherries or mountain areas where summer berries are still lingering. Bear activity begins to increase in September as they look to put on weight in advance of winter hibernation.

Grizzly bears can be found anywhere in the western two-thirds of Montana, and their distribution is denser and more widespread than in previous years. Some areas with dense concentrations of grizzly bears are very accessible to hunters. Keep these precautions in mind when hunting in grizzly country:

Carry and know how to use bear spray. Keep it within easy reach and be prepared to use it immediately.

Stay alert, especially when hearing or visibility is limited.

Bird hunters should be extra careful while walking in and along areas of brush, especially along waterways. Grizzly bears use thick cover for day beds.

Travel and hunt in groups whenever possible.

Follow all food storage regulations. Contact the applicable land management agency (i.e. U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, etc.) to learn what food storage rules apply where you're hunting.

Avoid carcass sites and concentrations of ravens and

Carry the equipment you need to process a carcass and get it out of the field as quickly as possible.

If you harvest an animal, remove it from the field as quickly as possible.



Hoot-owl fishing restrictions to be lifted, adjusted on several Montana rivers

Recent cooler temperatures will allow hoot-owl fishing restrictions to be lifted on Silver Bow Creek, and the lower Bitterroot, Clark Fork, Beaverhead, East Gallatin, Gallatin, Ruby and Smith rivers, effective immediately. Part of the closure on the Madison River upstream of Hebgen Reservoir will change to hoot-owl restrictions. Water temperatures have met the criteria to lift fishing restrictions and FWP expects the temperatures to remain cool.

Silver Bow Creek – in its entirety

Beaverhead River - from Highway 41 near East Bench Road and Beaverhead Rock to its confluence with the Big Hole River

East Gallatin River - from Penwell Bridge Road to the confluence with the Gallatin River

Gallatin River - from Amsterdam Road to the confluence with the Missouri River

Madison River - from downstream most Yellowstone National Park (YNP) boundary to Hebgen Reservoir will switch from a full closure to hoot-owl restrictions.

Ruby River - from Duncan District Road to confluence with the Beaverhead River







Burials at First Baptist Church of Dillon?

We are researching James Alexander Stark Agee, known locally as Allie Stark. She was born in Missouri in 1878 and was given the name of her father, James Alexander Stark, who had died a few months before her birth. She was married to John Calvin Agee. They had several children, four of whom were with her when she left Idaho and came to Dillon about 1913, where she died in 1917. Her death certificate, her obits and her funeral record all say or suggest Allie was buried in Mountain View Cemetery, although the city did not record her burial. This in itself does not mean much, as the city neglected to record many burials in those days.

Someone has said that Allie Stark was first buried in the church yard of the First Baptist Church in Dillon and that the burials at the church were moved to Mountain View Cemetery when the new church was built. The original church, erected in 1887, was demolished in early 1946 due to previous earthquake damage and rebuilt on the same site in 1948. We can find no mention or evidence of burials at the Baptist church; no burial records of any removed from the Baptist church yard and reburied at Mountain View Cemetery; no news clips regarding removal of burials from the church yard, neither during demolition of the original church nor during erection of the new one; no photos that show graves at the church before it was demolished.

Second-Half Surge Not Enough as Montana Western Falls to Montana Tech 38-27

The Montana Western football team (0-1) was clipped by rival Montana Tech (1-0) 38-27 in Butte. Despite holding the hosts to just seven points in the second half, the Bulldogs could not overcome the 21-point hole they found themselves

in after the first quarter.

"Tech deserves all the credit for a great win, they outplayed us in every way," UMW head coach Ryan Nourse said. "They desired to win and most of our team merely wanted it to happen. Big games are normally won by the team that makes the fewest mistakes and makes big plays in special teams, and that was Tech today, not the Bulldogs. We have a long way to go to see if we can make this a great team, and we will regroup tomorrow and start working on improving and growing.

Michael Palandri paced the Bulldog offense, throwing for 285 yards and three touchdowns while also taking one to the house himself. Eli Nourse racked up 188 total yards and caught the first touchdown from Palandri to put UMW on the board.

Seth Shook (85 yards) and Landon Charlton (24 yards) also tallied receiving touchdowns for Western.

Connor Dunlea led UMW's defensive efforts, recording 11 total tackles, including four solo take downs. Tyler Schoen (nine) and Jace Fitzgerald (eight) ranked second and third in tackles, respectively. Fitzgerald led the game in solo tackles with seven, three more than any other player.

On special teams, Maclain Burckley was three-for-three on point-after attempts. He registered six punts for 247 yards.

UMW held the statistical advantage in first downs (20-18), total offense (390-387), and passing yards (285), but the Orediggers came out on top in rushing yards (214-105). The biggest difference-maker in the contest was on special teams, with Montana Tech reaching 200 total return yards

compared to just 26 from the Bulldogs.

Levi Torgerson put in a strong shift for Tech, recording 203 return vards and two return touchdowns. He opened the game with a 100-yard kickoff return to put the Orediggers up early, and followed that up with a 91-yard punt return later in the game.

Jarrett Wilson also earned a passing TD for the hosts, going 7-9 for 77 yards. Wykece Johnson rushed for 167 yards, including a 74-yard touchdown run, while Nick Michelotti and Parker Johnston each caught a touchdown pass as well.

Ken Downing, of the Club Royal, announces a jack pot rodeo will be held Sunday at the rodeo grounds adjoining the Club Royal. Participants will furnish their own stock.

There will be saddle brone and bareback riding, calf roping and buildogging. The rodeo will start at 1 p. m., with an admission charge to spectators of 50c.

If the event proves popular, it is Mr. Downing's intention to hold a weekly rodeo on Sundays.

The Club Royal will also hold a dance Saturday and Sunday nights. Rodeos were held at the Club Royal from about 1953 through 1958. Bob Meine provided bucking horses for the rodeos. One was named the Grey Ghost, who went on to buck at Madison Square Gardens.
