Attorney General Knudsen warns of dangers

Attorney General Austin Knudsen is warning Montanans of the dangers of 7-hydroxymitragynine (7-OH), a widely available over-the-counter opioid. 7-OH is a concentrated byproduct of the kratom plant that has a high potential of misuse and can even cause death.

The chemical makeup of 7-OH has a dangerously high potency when consumed and can cause respiratory depression, physical dependence, and withdrawal symptoms similar to some of the most powerful opioids including fentanyl, morphine, and oxycodone; and in some cases, can lead to death. According to the Food and Drug Administration,7-OH is 13 times more potent than morphine. Since 2020, the Montana Department of Health and Human Services has recorded 29 deaths in Montana involving 7-OH.

Currently in Montana it is not listed as a controlled substance in the Montana Code Annotated or on any federal controlled substances list. 7-OH is not approved by the FDA, is not lawful in dietary supplements, and 7-OH cannot be lawfully added to conventional foods.

UMW Men's Cross Country Takes Fifth, Women Finish Eighth at MSU Bobcat Twilight

Montana Western's Harrison Silverio and Olivia Heiner were the top Bulldog finishers at the MSU Bobcat Twilight Friday evening in Bozeman.

Silverio clocked a 17:22.6 to finish 50th out of 84 competitors in the men's 5k. Heiner ran a 20:58.4 to take 46th out of 75 runners in the women's 5k.

"It was good to see both teams race today, and I think for the most part everyone raced well through the first 3k," head coach Taylor Grove said. "I am hoping to work on finishing strong through the last half of the race in the coming weeks. We have three weeks of training before our next race, so this was just a starting place, and I think we are in a good spot for the beginning of the season."

The other finishers on the men's side included Brant Heiner (54th, 17:48.4), Brody Henry (57th, 18:01.0), Kreg Butler (60th, 18:12.7), Cael Thilmony (61st, 18:13.1), Tristan Von Bargen (68th, 18:44.1), Noah Rovente (71st, 19:24.3), Bridger Wheeler (73rd, 19:31.7), and Mason Lynch (75th, 19:39.4).

Thilmony, Van Bargen, and Lynch all made their collegiate debuts. On the women's side, Justene Santi (59th, 22:02.3), Ashley Murnion (71st, 25:06.31), and Kylee Wyatt (74th, 28:02.9) rounded out the Bulldog finishers.

It marked a collegiate debut for Murnion.



Upcoming MT 91 closure north of Dillon

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and its partner Razz Construction will be replacing a bridge deck on Montana Highway 91 (MT 91) just north of Dillon. During this work, MT 91 will be closed between mile marker 0.0 and 1.0.

Motorists will need to follow the signed detour during the closure. From the south end of the project area, beginning at the MT 91 and North Montana Street intersection, travelers will turn north onto Laknar Lane, west onto Schuler Lane, and then south onto MT 91. The approximate detour length is 3.5 miles.

Construction is scheduled to begin the week of September 15 and continue through January 2026, weather and other factors permitting.

Veteran's Corner Update #324 By Mike Lawson

Veteran News Updates:

- Our Marine Corps League, Det. #724, ran the "Beer Garden" for Montana Tech's Homecoming football game with Western Montana College. A lot of people were there from both colleges, especially with Western being only 64 miles away, in Dillon, south of Butte. It was a good game and as a MCL Detachment, we sold a lot of beer and had fun interacting with the crowd. It was another community event we volunteered to participate in. We wore our MCL Covers (hats), had our donation jars out and people were generous in their donations. All the proceeds from the beer sales went to the Montana Tech Foundation. It was good exposure for us and the interaction with the folks there resulted in a great/fun time.
- Stress can be very debilitating to anyone and Veterans are as susceptible to it as well. This is especially true if the Veteran is dealing with PTSD. The VA is suggesting five quick strategies to regain one's calm. They call it "Grounding Exercise: Connecting with our senses". Don't let life overwhelm you - try these five steps to manage stress: (1) Go for a walk or roll: Move your body and calm your mind. If you have taken a walk outside in a time of stress, you probably noticed the magic of your entire mood changing. Fresh air, movement and a new view makes the difference. (2) Chat with a friend or loved one: Connect and release. You're not alone. Sometimes when feeling stressed, it's helpful to reach out to someone you trust. It doesn't have to be a deep conservation; even a quick text or a five minute call can make a world of difference. (3) Visualize something positive or hopeful: Change your inner channel. Our minds are powerful, sometimes too powerful for their own good. Stress can often hijack our imagination, making us think of the worst case scenarios. Think of a positive time where it felt safe, etc.. (4) Put on some music and dance: Shake it out , literally. (5) Engage in a quick mindfulness exercise: Find calming in the present... For more information on these five steps, check out your local VA Whole Health Point of View. This next week-end will see a number of us Vietnam Veterans going on an Honor Flight to Washington D.C.. I'm excited and will report on it in my next Veteran's Corner column.







HOW TO TALK TO AN OLDER ADULT ABOUT SUICIDAL THOUGHTS



Conversations about suicide can be deeply uncomfortable—and yet, they're often essential. This is especially true when speaking with older adults, who may be quietly struggling with emotional pain, isolation, or a sense of hopelessness.

Many people hesitate to ask an older parent, grandparent, neighbor, or friend if they're having suicidal thoughts. It can feel intrusive, awkward, or even frightening. But asking the question—directly and compassionately—can be a powerful act of care.

STEPS FOR A PRODUCTIVE CONVERSATION

- 1. Start with observation, not judgement: Rather than confronting or diagnosing, gently reflect what you've noticed. For example: "You haven't seemed like yourself lately, and I've been a little worried. Would it be okay if we talked for a bit?"
- 2. Ask with kindness and clarity: It's okay to be direct. You might say: "When people feel overwhelmed by health issues or life changes, they sometimes think about ending their lives. Have you had thoughts like that?"
- 3. If they say yes: Thank them for trusting you, offer reassurance and support, and collaborate with them on the next steps to get them in touch with a doctor or counselor. If the threat is serious enough, know when to escalate and seek immediate medical intervention.
- 4. **If they say no:** Gently follow up. Sometimes a no or an unclear answer may be hiding something more. Even simply showing concern may have a meaningful impact and open the door for future conversations.
- 5. After the conversation: Support doesn't end after one conversation. Schedule a follow-up or check-in soon—this shows that your concern wasn't just a passing moment. Even small gestures, like sharing a meal or calling to say hello, can make a big impact.
