

Suspect Apprehended After Multi-Mile Chase Near Lima, MT Following Suspicious Gun Sale

A series of suspicious incidents and a lengthy vehicle pursuit on Monday led to the apprehension of a suspect after a tense and multi-mile chase involving deputies from Beaverhead County

The day began when Sheriff Dave Wendt was approached by a biker who reported an encounter earlier that day at Monida. The individual claimed they were approached by a person selling guns and claiming a relative had passed away. The buyer told the suspect they could go to Idaho Falls for cash but then changed plans to Lima. When the buyer entered an Exxon to use their ATM, the suspect noticed the marked sheriff's truck and left the scene quickly. Upon returning with the cash, the buyer was unable to locate the seller and approached Sheriff Wendt, reporting what happened. The buyer, suspecting the guns might be stolen, left the firearms with the sheriff.

On September 1st, at 6:07 p.m., dispatch alerted Sheriff Wendt to a suspicious person near Dell. A caller reported that a man had come to their door looking for work and tried to sell her husband a pistol. The vehicle matched the description from

Sheriff Wendt quickly began searching for the suspect, with Deputy Fields heading toward the area. Deputy fields passed the vehicle on Red Rock road as it was heading towards I-15. Deputy Fields activated his emergency lights. Instead of stopping, the driver fled, getting onto I-15 southbound.


Wendt set up stop sticks at the Red Rock fishing bridge, but the suspect ran through the median again, heading north on I-15.

Near the Beaverhead River, Sheriff Wendt positioned his vehicle behind a guardrail and deployed stop sticks, successfully spiking two of the tires. At this point, a third deputy joined the chase, and all three continued pursuit.

The suspect's vehicle began losing parts of its tires as the chase extended about four more miles. The driver attempted to cross the median again into oncoming traffic, prompting deputies to initiate a pit maneuver. However, initial efforts were complicated by oncoming traffic and the fleeing vehicle's erratic movements.

Deputy Fields managed to get alongside the suspect's car and pushed it off the road, bringing the pursuit to a close. The driver quickly exited the vehicle and surrendered about 80 yards away, ending the tense chase.

enforcement Law officials secured the scene and transported suspect into custody amid ongoing investigation into the initial gun sales and the suspect's activities.



Terminus Distilling Company Updates

Katrina & Derek Lewis

Building: The small tasting room is progressing nicely. Derek hung the ceiling with old punched tin tiles, originally from the atrium of Beaverhead County High School. After cleaning them up and flattening a few, he clear coated them to preserve their condition. We are working with Nate Mooney to rough in electrical service, including for interior and exterior lights. Derek hung sheetrock and Katrina is in the process of mudding, taping, and sanding. Outside, Derek has installed the walk up window, applied the waterproofing membrane, and installed some of the siding.

Last month we shared a little about the early history of our building, focusing on John W. Morton, the grocer who built it. In looking at the digitized Montana newspapers, Katrina has found some great advertising from this early period. Next month, we'll share about the building's next era

as a wholesale grocer: The Olmstead-Stevenson Company.

Business / Community: We've visited a few times with Jesse Scofield and Cory Birkenbuel to tour the building and talk about custom lighting in the tasting room. They both have great ideas on how to repurpose and reuse materials we have. We love Jesse's vision and are eager to be working with him.

Derek has traveled a few times this month to collect various items we've purchased from auctions and from Craigslist posts. Stainless steel tables for the manufacturing space, a commercial coffee grinder, a three compartment sink, a barrel style chair - little by little, these and other things will be helpful in upcoming phases of our distillery. Purchasing used items helps us save money and save these things from landfills.

Distillery: Dillon is rich in plums this year - our tree is producing, as are many of our neighbors'. The wealth of delicious fruit has us researching plum brandy (known as slivovitz in central and southeastern Europe, and a type of rakia in the Balkins). When we're up and running, we hope to produce an annual Community Brandy, using local produce donated when people have too much in their backyards. We'll need to get a fruit press as well as experiment with different yeast strains to find the right fit for various fruits.

Honeyberry picking has provided enough fruit to make a few different shrubs, including a deliciously tart batch with rhubarb. More news next month on shrub availability, especially if you live in Montana.

With mornings starting to feel cooler, we're looking forward to apple harvest and turning our attention to fall slushie flavors. We can't wait to share them with you soon!



Letter to the Editor

OH MY WORD!!!! I just read the article in the Dillon Tribune wherein Scott and Lisa Rakich applied for a variance and it was denied by all three county commissioners because it was in the floodway. They haven't followed the rules in the floodplain, floodfringe or floodway in 40 plus years. Now some poor couple in the county wants to put up a shop where a horse shed used to be and they stop their construction, threaten them with a cease and desist. I think Commissioner McGinley wants to give his away. They have allowed an illegal dike to remain after the flood in 1984 across the river from us. Supposedly the owners at the time were notified that it had to be removed. Dike is still there 41 years later. Do you think that pushes water onto us, of course it does. The Montana Department of Transportation and Beaverhead County bermed up a roadway to connect a bridge on Laknar Lane to replace the old Selway Bridge, bottle necking the river at the bridge. It placed all of us to the west of that berm and bridge behind a dam and when the river froze 2 winters ago, ice jammed up, and it shut off the flow at the bridge, causing water to run over the banks and flooded people on the north side that weren't even in the floodplain. They had never had water before including us on the south side. This berm is in the floodway. First time in 45 years of living on this river that we ever got water up to our house. They did not acquire any permits from the Corp of Engineers or have it surveyed or designed by the Corp of Engineers, which are also rules in the floodplain. My suggestion Scott/Lisa, put a big door in the front of the shop and a big door in the back of the shop and promise them if you ever get water there from a flood, you will open both doors and let it run through. If you didn't get water in 1984 from that slough, I don't think it should be a problem. They really need to concentrate on rectifying the illegal structures that are causing problems.

Fishing restrictions to be lifted on the Blackfoot and Upper Rock Creek Thursday

Due to shorter days and longer nights resulting in cooler water temperatures, fishing restrictions will be lifted on the Blackfoot River and upper Rock Creek effective Thursday, Sept. 4. Water temperatures have routinely been below criteria and FWP expects the temperatures to remain cool.

Blackfoot River: Hoot owl restrictions will be lifted Thursday on the entire Blackfoot River main stem - from the headwaters at the confluence of Anaconda Creek and Beartrap Creek to the confluence with the Clark Fork River.

Rock Creek: Hoot owl restrictions will be lifted Thursday on upper Rock Creek – from the confluence of the West and Middle forks to the mouth of Stoney Creek. The remainder of Rock Creek was not under hoot owl.

The restrictions had been in effect for the rivers due to warm water temperatures. Hoot-owl restrictions prohibit fishing from 2 p.m. to midnight each day. They are designed to protect fish that become more susceptible to disease and mortality when high water temperatures combine with other stressors, including catch-and-release fishing.

Anglers can reduce stress on fish at all times of the year by getting fish to the net or in hand quickly, keeping them in the water, and reviving them prior to releasing them back into the river.

Along with monitoring stream temperatures, FWP also monitors stream flows, and in some streams, holds instream flow water rights. FWP's water program can issue a call on junior water users, when appropriate, to contribute to stream flows through the late summer and early fall.





Fishing for Chinook salmon on Fort Peck Reservoir this summer has been a very popular activity. This is the only Chinook salmon fishery in Montana, so anglers travel from near and far in hopes of hooking up with one of these unique fish.

Salmon were first introduced into Fort Peck Reservoir in 1983. Due to the abundance of their preferred forage fish – cisco – salmon have shown excellent growth, with males maturing in two to four years and females in three to four years...often leading to large fish of 20 pounds or more.

Although the summer salmon fishing season (which is usually done with boats, downriggers and trolling in deep water) is winding down as we get closer to fall, the much more "accessible" snagging and archery season will be begin starting Oct. 1, along with FWP's annual salmon egg collection efforts.

Egg collection efforts

Chinook salmon cannot successfully spawn naturally in the reservoir, so staff must collect fish, harvest the eggs and raise them in the hatchery over the winter. In the spring of 2025, a total 230,000 Chinook salmon were released back into Fort Peck from the fall of 2024 egg take.

FWP fisheries and hatchery staff will begin collecting adult Chinook salmon on Fort Peck starting the first week of October. The annual collection effort lasts through much of October, with the goal of collecting enough eggs to fill the Fort Peck Hatchery. Salmon are then raised in the hatchery and will be released back into the reservoir in the spring of 2026.

Angling opportunities for salmon

The salmon snagging and archery season begins Wednesday, Oct. 1. The archery season runs through Oct. 15 and the snagging season runs through Nov. 30. This popular fishery brings in a lot of folks to the bays and boat ramps at the lower (dam end) of Fort Peck Reservoir, as the salmon tend to congregate near boat ramps and shorelines where they were first stocked.

In addition, anglers should not clean, fillet or leave carcasses on docks, ramps or shorelines. Not only is this unsightly and unethical, it can bring in scavengers and other unwanted pests to these areas.

Lastly, please be aware of fishery crews and their electrofishing efforts, as they may be near areas where angling activities are taking place. These efforts are crucial to obtaining enough eggs for the hatchery to continue this popular and unique fishery.
