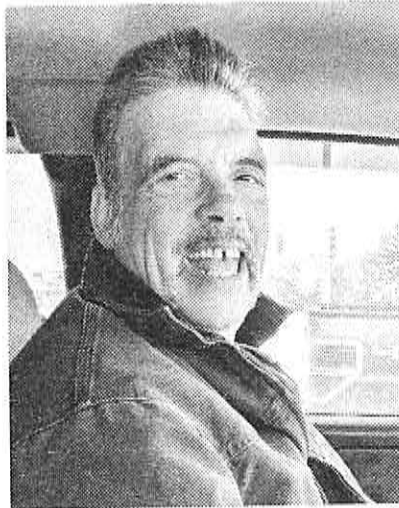

January 16, 1966 – September 2, 2025



Andrew Richard Dooling, 59, known lovingly as Andy, passed away after a short courageous battle with cancer. He was a devoted husband, a proud father, a steadfast brother, a loving son and a man who never met a stranger – he was a friend to all.

Andy was born in New Britain, CT – but was raised on a ranch in Dillon, Montana, where his strong work ethic and love of family took root. He was active in his parents, Ann and Thomas

Dooling's, Cashmere Goat Project, serving as the lead shearer. Those ranch years shaped not only his grit and determination, but also his boundless energy and sense of humor. His love for sports started in high school when he became an all-conference defensive player at Beaverhead High School. He also loved his Patriots and watched NFL regularly. He was a cowboy through and through, sometimes getting into fights with his brother Joe if he had scheduled branding day during a time Andy wasn't available. His lifelong buddy Troy and he would run the calf table, just the two of them. In 1993, soon after the birth of his second daughter, he started his own excavation business – something he took a lot of pride in.

Shortly after high school, Andy met and married Maggie Hopewell and together they had 3 girls: Christina, Kathleen (Kady), and Ann Drew Dooling. Soon after separating, Andy met his wife Joyce Vanover, whom he loved more than anything. Joyce was a package deal and Andy happily became a stepfather to Amber Buscher, making him a father to 4 beautiful girls. Joyce and Andy lived a life full of love, laughter, and ultimately resilience. She was his rock through everything and supported him through every adversity he faced in his later life. Nothing made him prouder than watching his daughters grow, succeed, and create their own paths in the world. He was a very proud Papa to Kynleigh Carlson and Noah Souza. He loved his grandchildren so much.

Andy was one of ten children, and while each relationship was unique, he shared an especially strong bond with his three brothers; Steven, his Irish twin, Tom, his motorcycle buddy, and Joe, his baby brother. One of Andy's favorite things to do was to go out to his brother Joe's ranch – either for branding or one of Joe's last-minute ideas that involved his using the excavator.

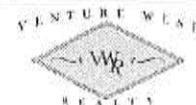

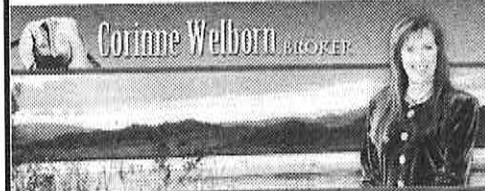

Life: Inside and Out 2025-2026 Season Lineup

The University of Montana Western's Biology Department speaker series, Life: Inside and Out (LIO), is underway for the 2025-2026 academic year. LIO invites scientists from across the country to share their research with the Montana Western and Dillon communities in a way that is accessible to students and the general public. LIO invites all to attend the next presentation, "High-elevation Pine Physiological Responses to Drought" by Dr. Danielle Ulrich, on Wednesday, September 17, in UMW's Lucy Carson Library.

UMW professor Dr. Michael Gilbert gives a presentation at LIO in August 2025.

The series offers opportunities to learn directly from experts about exciting biological research happening today and possible career paths students might pursue with firsthand knowledge. All are welcome to attend.

The first LIO presentation, held on August 20, showcased the research of the Montana Western Biology faculty and highlighted opportunities for students to participate in scientific projects. Our students engage in a wide range of research, from investigating antibiotic-resistant bacteria in local waterways to studying parasites that infect fish, exploring the internal anatomy of sharks and horses, and examining chronic wasting disease in local deer populations (a project recently awarded \$350,000 from NSF).

LIO presentations take place on the first Wednesday of every block at 4:00 p.m. on the first floor of the Lucy Carson Library. The detailed schedule for the remainder of the academic year is listed below.

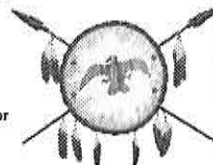

Montana State Auditor James Brown Urges Congress to Protect Investment Contract Law

Montana State Auditor and Commissioner of Securities and Insurance James Brown has joined regulators across the country in a hard-hitting call for Congress to scrap a dangerous federal proposal that would tie the hands of state fraud enforcers and embolden financial criminals.

In a letter organized by the North American Securities Administrators Association (NASAA) and sent to Senate Banking Committee leaders on September 5, Auditor Brown and other top regulators demanded the immediate removal of Section 105 from the proposed federal market

structure legislation — a provision that Brown warns would cripple states' ability to go after crypto scammers, Ponzi schemers, and financial predators. Montana State Auditor James Brown is highly supportive of the efforts to create a market framework for digital assets, but not without the ability to protect Montanans from bad actors.

"Congress needs to know: Section 105 is a gift to fraudsters," said Auditor Brown. "It would gut the legal tools we use to investigate, charge, and convict those who prey on hardworking Montanans. I won't stand by when we have a federal statute that enables the fraud that I am working every day to prosecute here in Montana."

Over the past decade, state regulators have led the charge in shutting down complex digital asset frauds, often where no federal action was taken. Brown emphasized that Montana's state-level enforcement authority has been critical to holding bad actors accountable and trying to ensure restitution to victims. Montana has been an example to the rest of the country in this effort with fulltime public awareness campaigns, aggressive prosecutions of fraudsters, and ensure Montana victims have access to restitution through the restitution fund. This is a fund that Montana and only a small number of states have that help victims piece their lives back together. That power helps Montanans. This power must not be diluted by Washington.

To safeguard enforcement powers, Brown is calling for Congress to adopt the Support Anti-Fraud Enforcement (SAFE) Act, which would:

- Cement states' authority to investigate and prosecute fraud involving securities, commodities, and digital assets.
- Prevent federal laws from overriding critical state powers.
- Maintain the flexible legal tests that have proven effective in court.
