

Fish and Wildlife Commission updates public comments process

The Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission will simplify its approach to collecting public comment on agenda items beginning with the December commission meeting. The changes will ensure comments collected prior to the meeting will be seen by commissioners and collected in an efficient manner.

Montana Fish. Wildlife & Parks staff collect public comments on behalf of the commission for agenda items prior to commission meetings. These agenda items are proposals presented to the commission by FWP.

This change incorporates two methods for collecting public comments: via physical mail and through an online portal established for each agenda item.

"Our online portal is operated by SurveyMonkey, which allows individuals to submit comments and upload attachments." said FWP Director Christy Clark. "The advantage of the online portal is that the technology automatically compiles every comment and attachment into a single readable document. This ensures accuracy and minimizes the potential for human error."

FWP and the Fish and Wildlife Commission are separate entities. However, under Montana law, the commission is responsible for making specific decisions related to the work conducted by FWP. This includes approving hunting and fishing regulations, land purchases, and various rule changes.

The public process for items on the commission agenda begins with FWP proposals that are open for public comment approximately two months prior to a commission meeting. Commissioners can propose amendments to these proposals, which also go out for public comment. Additionally, commissioners may propose amendments during commission meetings. The commission accepts public comments during public meetings as well.

The next Fish and Wildlife Commission meeting is scheduled for Dec. 4.





Montana Western Fine Arts Gallery Presents "The Series of Christ"

The University of Montana Western Fine Arts Gallery is honored to present "The Series of Christ" by the late Jim Corr, a distinguished alumnus, educator, artist, and coach. The exhibition will open on Thursday, October 30, and will feature a gallery reception from 5:00–7:00 p.m. in the Fine Arts Gallery, located in Main Hall.

The first painting in this series, The Appearance (1975, Oil on Canvas), came to Jim during a time of deep personal sorrow. After his son Mick suffered a serious motorcycle accident, Jim turned to painting as a way to process his grief and seek solace. What began as a simple background with an airbrush evolved into an unplanned image—Christ's face emerging from the canvas. This unexpected moment inspired a profound spiritual journey. Each piece in "The Series of Christ" reflects the emotions Jim experienced through his son's recovery—hope, sorrow, anger, forgiveness, and acceptance. The series reveals the deeply human side of Christ, mirroring Jim's own empathy and connection as a father and believer. The paintings were, as Jim described, both a prayer and a healing process to the sorrow.

A 1954 graduate of Western Montana College of Education (now the University of Montana Western), Jim Corr earned degrees in English and Fine Arts, with a minor in Physical Education, followed by a master's in education in 1961. As a student, Jim was a three-sport letterman and captain of the baseball team, served as president of Kappa Pi, and contributed to the Chinook yearbook staff. His legacy continued as a teacher, coach, and mentor—spanning 16 years in Montana public schools before returning to Montana Western as an art instructor, gallery director, art club advisor, and coach. Jim's impact on the university community is lasting. He was inducted into the UMW Athletic Hall of Fame (1992), received the Alumni Distinguished Service Award (1994), and was honored in the UMW Education Hall of Fame (2015). Jim "Lefty" Corr passed away on September 19, 2017, doing what he loved—walking down the ninth hole after a great drive at the Beaverhead Golf Course.





Fish and Wildlife Commission makes changes to deer B licenses in northeast Montana

Changes come in response to EHD outbreak

During its meeting Oct. 9, the Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission made a regulation change to limit the number of white-tailed deer licenses in northeast Montana in response to hemorrhagic disease outbreaks in the area.

The commission voted to limit the sale of the region-wide 006-00 deer B licenses to 2,000 total and only allow one 006-00 deer B license per hunter. Hunters that purchased more than one 006-00 license prior to Oct. 10 can still use those licenses. At the time of the meeting Thursday about 1,400 of the licenses had been sold this year.

The action is in response to late summer and early fall outbreaks of epizootic hemorrhagic disease (EHD) and blue tongue (BT) in northeast Montana, primarily along the Milk River from Nashua to Havre. Hunters should be prepared for lower numbers of white-tailed deer along sections of the Milk River and may want to focus efforts elsewhere in the region where populations were not affected.

Both EHD and BT are viral diseases transmitted by biting midges and primarily affect white-tailed deer, though mule deer and other

species can also be impacted.

The viruses are often fatal and can result in large numbers of dead animals in a very localized area. Though the regulation change made by the commission will address some concerning outbreaks in northeast Montana, this year FWP field staff have found cases of these diseases around the state.

While the disease can cause significant losses in localized deer populations, outbreaks are usually short-lived and confined to certain areas. With the recent below freezing temperatures, FWP expects mortalities related to EHD/BT to slow.

Hemorrhagic diseases are not a risk to humans, and meat from animals that appear healthy at the time of harvest remains safe to eat when properly cooked. Hunters should avoid harvesting or consuming animals that appear sick.

FWP will continue to track the extent of the outbreak and provide updates as needed. For more information about hemorrhagic disease in Montana, visit fwp.mt.gov/conservation/diseases.
