



Hunters: Stop at all designated check stations

During the general big game season, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks runs biological game check stations on weekends around the state. Please remember that all hunters are required by law to stop at all designated check stations on their way to and from hunting, even if they have no game to be checked. If you are hunting and see check station signage along the roadway, please pull in where directed.

Biologists gather a lot of valuable information at these check stations, working with hunters to collect wildlife data and gauge hunter participation and harvest rates.

At these stations, you won't be asked for your hunting license, but biologists will enter the sex and species of your animal, check the teeth for aging purposes, and measure the antlers or horns if it is a male. Some stations also offer the option to have animals sampled for CWD if desired. Hunters also will be asked for a general area of where they were hunting, what game they were after, how many were in their party, where they are from, if they were hunting on public, private or fee land, and if they were satisfied with their hunt.

Please follow all directions and signs from FWP staff as they work diligently to check game, answer questions, and get you on your way. FWP staff greatly appreciate all hunters' cooperation in this effort.

Secretary Christi Jacobsen stands for Montana values, champions public access, support and protection for timber and mining industries with Montana Great Outdoors Conservation Easement

Montana Secretary of State Christi Jacobsen exemplified Montana values during the October Land Board meeting, championing public access for Montana hunters, anglers, and recreationists while showcasing the importance of supporting and protecting the timber and mining industries.

Secretary Jacobsen advocated for all Montanans regarding a proposed conservation easement, known as the Montana Great Outdoors Conservation Easement, consisting of tens of thousands of acres in western Montana. Secretary Jacobsen emphasized that Montana's hunters, anglers, and recreationists benefit from increased public access opportunities. She also highlighted the importance of supporting and protecting the timber and mining industries, which are vital for sustaining production to provide jobs, resources, and a flourishing economy for Montana.

Phase II of the Montana Great Outdoors Conservation Easement

was ultimately approved with a 4-1 vote.

"Montana earned her title as the Treasure State because of her abundant resources, and it's crucial that we safeguard surface and mineral rights to ensure sustainable development of all of our natural resources," she added. "I will always support Montana's identity as the Treasure State and its reputation as the Last Best Place."

'Best in the West'

Montana's Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) team was recently recognized by the Western Regional Panel (WRP) of the Aquatic Nuisance Species Task Force as the 2025 "Best in the West" for its exceptional work preventing the spread of invasive species across the state's waters.

The award honors the dedication and collaboration of AIS professionals and partners statewide, including staff from Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks, tribal programs, conservation districts and local organizations. Together, these teams play a critical role in protecting Montana's waterways from harmful invasive species like zebra and quagga mussels.

So far this year, over 97,000 boats have been inspected across the state, and 36 mussel- fouled watercraft were intercepted and more than 550 have been intercepted transporting aquatic weeds.

Montana's AIS Early Detection Laboratory has analyzed over 2,100 microscopy samples for mussel early detection with no evidence of invasive mussels detected. Over 240 environmental DNA samples have been processed so far this season for invasive mussels with no evidence of invasive mussel DNA detected.

Among this year's honorees is Garland "Ham" Hamilton, FWP Region 1 watercraft inspector in Kalispell, who was individually recognized as a Best in the West recipient for his commitment to public service and excellence in watercraft inspection.

The WRP also recognized several Montana partners for their outstanding contributions:

Rob Howard, AIS program manager for the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes, for his leadership and dedication to quality inspections and customer service.

Jeff Kemp, Swan Lakers Board President, for more than a decade of volunteer leadership and coordination of AIS inspection efforts at Swan Lake.

Team AIS Montana, a statewide coalition of agencies, tribes, local governments, conservation groups, and nonprofits working together to prevent, detect, and respond to AIS threats.

"This recognition is a testament to the incredible teamwork happening across Montana," said Thomas Woolf, FWP's aquatic invasive species bureau chief.

Across Montana, FWP personnel play a vital role in the state's AIS efforts, helping maintain a coordinated, effective prevention program. Their commitment continues to protect Montana's lakes, rivers and fisheries for generations to come.
